EARLY SMARTS GUIDELINES

Enrollment

Students can only enroll in one workshop per week. Enrollment opens live online Wednesday, June 1 @ 1:30 pm. There are four Early SMARTS workshops with 48 spots for students and their accompanying adult. See the K-12 Flyer for those workshops. Workshops must fill to 50% capacity in order to run. All workshops are free, open to the public, and offered on a first-come, first-served basis to students who have applications on file with SMARTS. Apply here: www.SmartsArtSchool.org/classes.

Early SMARTS Eligibility & Attendance

Students who have not yet entered Kindergarten may take an Early SMARTS workshop. Students can sign up for more than one Early SMARTS workshop, but each workshop is limited to two members per household. All Early SMARTS students must be accompanied by an adult (parent, guardian or grandparent). Attendance both days of the workshop is mandatory. Please do not enroll in a workshop if you cannot attend both days.

Masks, Health, and Safety
