Dear SMARTS Friends,

SMARTS, Students Motivated by the Arts, is celebrating our 28th year in the community as a leader in arts education. As many of you know, we do this by providing *free* classes to PK-12 students in visual art, music, dance, theater, and creative writing. The time has come once again for our yearly celebration of local art - the Joy of SMARTS! This event is a continuation of "Art for SMARTS," created in 2014 and renamed for past SMARTS Circle member and longtime friend, Joy White. Joy initially started the event, and it is because of her vision for SMARTS' future and belief in our Mission that allows us to continue her legacy. I know many of you were friends of Joy's.

We are reaching out to emerging and established artists in our community to ask you to consider donating one or more pieces of your original art OR pieces from your collection of other artists' work that could find a new home to put up for auction at this event. our goal this year is to acquire 120 (or more!) original works that will be auctioned or sold at this event. All art donors will be recognized in our digital event program and applicable press materials. You'll also be our guest at the VIP Preview Party and attend for free (you will receive *one* VIP ticket; VIP tickets for this fundraiser are \$55 each, and \$30 for general admission). If you choose to donate, you will receive a letter after the event for tax purposes regarding your donation. If your piece does not sell, we will price it in the SMARTS Store for sale throughout the year.

At this event, you will have an opportunity to meet and mingle with friends and patrons of SMARTS, enjoy live music, watch live arts demonstrations, and purchase art and SWAG from the SMARTS Store. This is an adult event, so be ready to enjoy light appetizers and a cash bar! All proceeds from this event will go to furthering SMARTS' reach in our community. With your help, last year we raised \$41,000 with this event!

Guidelines for Artwork Donations

- 1. All donations must be original artwork(s) created by an artist. Examples include (but are not limited to): signed and numbered prints, paintings, photography, sculpture, arts lessons/services, handmade clothing and jewelry, etc. They can be decorative, commercial, and/or fine art. We prefer that donations arrive display-ready, although we can work with you to prepare your work (please contact us for more details).
- 2. Donors must complete the attached donation form, or go to *link here* (or scan QR code). Artwork will be accepted now through Friday, June 13, 2025.
- 3. Images of donated artworks may be used for publicity and/or promotional purposes and included in the event program.
